LIXI DevCloud Standards Lab

A First in Standards Management Environment

We are pleased to advise that LIXI is currently piloting a DevCloud Standards Lab with eight of our members. The DevCloud is a GitLab standards repository service, developed to improve the standards evolution / feedback loop. It provides a transparent, collaborative environment that facilitates participation in the development of emerging standards ahead of formal submission. It is anticipated that the DevCloud will allow members to build new standards with greater ease and transparency. It will also facilitate branching, which will allow leading edge developments to evolve in parallel to the existing standard. This will greatly enhance the evolution of LIXI standards and will maximise industry-wide benefit and adoption.
